The Keith Ferris Photo Walk-Around

How many times have you gone to your files for photographs of a particular aircraft only to find that you missed certain vital details when you had the opportunity? You never know what details you may require in the future, so a standardized walk-around designed to give the greatest coverage in a reasonable number of photos may be useful. These reference shots are strictly designed to be as thorough as possible rather than great photography. Additional photos from a platform or building, to get better coverage of the upper surface, would be helpful. In any case, be consistent and always do your photo walk-around when the opportunity arises. You will be thankful that you did when you find yourself drawing, painting or sculpting that aircraft.
